Why be an apprentice?

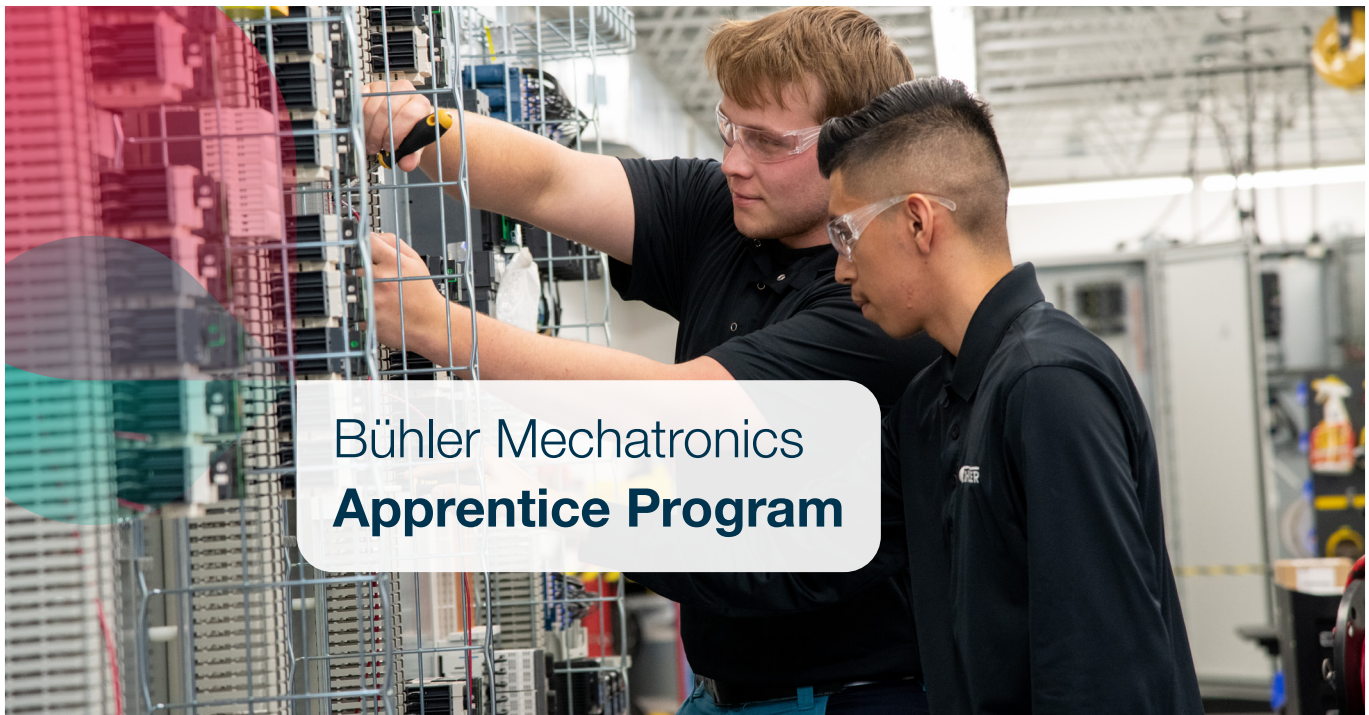
